Sandra Wagner addressed the board regarding a dog park that has been discussed and if the board was ready to start the construction of it. Mrs. Wagner stated that the cost of the fencing alone would be increasing by 30% after January and it would be most cost effective to have it built as soon as possible.

Mayor Bova stated that the Village Trustees had been talking to the Town Supervisor with regards to their portion of the funding and it was stated that the Town of Chautauqua would be placing \$5000.00 in their tentative budget to help fund the project, but that it would not be until January to be certain that the Town Board approves the amount to be spent. Location of the park was also discussed as it is the feeling of the Village Board that the park should be built on the Town of Chautauqua property and that since they are the agency that administers dog licensing. Mayor Bova stated that he would also place \$5000.00 in his tentative budget for the funding of a dog park as well. Mayor Bova asked that Mrs. Wagner return in April at that point the board would know for sure that the Town portion was in their budget and approved as well as the Village should be a point with their budget to determine if the \$5000.00 would be approved in their final budget.

Dave Niedzwiecki asked the board what action could be taken to have the derelict structure located on the corner of Morris and Valley street taken care of as it continues to be an eye sore and safety hazard in the neighborhood.

Mayor Bova instructed the Code Enforcement Officer Ed Cannon to contact the Village Attorney and file a notice of violation forcing a court hearing to get some action with the current owner to take care of the problems. It was stated that the current building permit would be expiring in December of this year and that it would at this point based on current actions not be renewed as nothing has been done during the past year to repair the building as stated in the current permit.
