New Rules for Yard Waste Brush, Limb & Grass Clipping Collection




- Limbs and branches are collected on the first and third Monday of each month.
- Limbs/branches should be no longer than 10' and 6" in diameter, cut from trees or shrubs. No whole trees are
- Please place all limbs and branches neatly stacked parallel to the street, with the butt end facing the direction of traffic.
- Yard waste such as grass clippings, garden waste, weeds, twigs, and tree droppings will be picked up every Monday.
- container with a lid or drain holes for your yard waste no plastic bags permitted.
- Your containers must placed by the street on Sunday evening or before 7:30 am on Monday.
- Please be aware that any yard waste not in containers will not be collected

Open Burning: Part 2

Burning ban in effect from March 16 through May 14 via NY DEC management policy

- Open Burning Regulations:

 No unattended fires
 Fire must be extinguished before being left unattended
 Fire extinguishing materials present during the fire

Open Burning Authorization:

- Bonfire Permit required
 Recreational Fire/Portable Fireplace No permit required

Any unauthorized or non-permitted fires will be promptly extinguished by the local fire code authorities or a New York Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) official.

Common Burning Problems:

- Smoke/Odor
 Damage to property
 Harm to people, animals, and/or pets
 Quality of Village life and appeal
 Penalties/Fines
